## READING

- Reading takes us places. It is the heart of $4^{\text {th }}$ grade.
- We have a goal for each child to read 40 books this year. At least 20 minutes of reading at home per night is expected to help achieve this goal. Carry books with you and take advantage of unused minutes in the car, waiting for events, etc.
- Please help your children have access to a variety of books and reading material. Talk to them about their reading.
- The Kamas Library is a great resource. They will find books on loan or order new books if you ask. Borrow books from our classroom.
- Park City Library usually has a great used book sale over Labor Day weekend.
- Visit thrift stores, shop bookorders and bookfairs, get reading incentive books from Barnes and Noble.
- Talk to me about ways to help your individual child.



## MATH

- $4^{\text {th }}$ Grade math is challenging! We have amazing smart students who can do hard things!
- We use class time for direct instruction and practice. I will assign homework practice sheets, IXL, or iReady frequently for homework. IXL will work on any desktop, laptop, phone, or tablet. Let me know if you have technology issues.
- Math facts need to be solid. This will make math easier for years to come. Reflex math can be accessed at home for math fact practice as well as the fluency part of ST Math. Use flash cards, count by $6,7,8$ 's etc. when you are in the car, listen to Youtube multiplication songs, or practice speed timings.
- Other Homework will be on an as needed basis.
- Please take advantage of at-home learning opportunities communicated through class newsletters.
- Have students use math in real life: cooking, money, measuring, etc.


## SCIENCE AND SOCIAL STUDIES

- Take advantage of the many learning opportunities Utah offers in nature, museums, recreation, wildlife, etc. Point out geography, counties, interesting places.
- Look for resources I'll send through e-mail such as the $4^{\text {th }}$ grade National Park pass and museum free days.
- Some home studying will be required to do their best on science tests.
- Students will need to study for Utah Citizen tests and there will be a couple optional projects.
- We have some fabulous themed learning days and field trips planned to help students have hands-on-learning. We are planning to visit This is the Place on September $2^{\text {nd }}$
